Principal's Message

It is my great pleasure to be able to convey a message for the PTA newsletter of Sir Ellis Kadoorie Secondary School (West Kowloon). Last school year (2012-13) was an extremely fruitful and remarkable year for SEKSS(WK). Apart from the general improvement of our students in discipline and studies as recognized by stakeholders, our students obtained a lot of awards in various inter-school competitions. I would like to highlight some of them such as the Hang Lung Mathematics Gold Award, Six outstanding performers and the best coordination awards in the HK School Drama Festival and two champions, one 2nd runner-up awards in the Boulder Fence Model Design Competition (Junior).

Regarding academic performance, our students achieved very good results in English Language and very satisfactory results in category A subjects in the HKDSE and with the best student attaining 2(5**), 4(5*) and

1(5) while students' performance in Applied Learning, GCSE(Chi), GCE(AS)(Chi) and Other Languages were excellent.



Knowing our students' talent in performing arts, resources have been allocated for a musical drama production leading to the participation in the Inter-school Drama Festival. Moreover, a new partnership programme with NGOs to offer Fashion Design mentorship programme has also been included in our Aesthetic programme. Via these programmes our students have been found to have developed a better understanding of their own potential and talent. Moreover, I am very glad to announce that our old D & T room has been converted into a new mini-hall and two multi-purposes rooms for other languages and aesthetic education for supporting aesthetic and language development of our students. All these have been found very effective in building up students' self-confidence and self-esteem.

Under the NSS academic structure, we are very serious about personal development and careers education of our students as secondary 6 graduates would encounter multi-pathways. To prepare them for their future challenges, mentorship schemes for assisting them to set their life goals have been offered by alumni and NGOs. Activities on life experience sharing and visits would be organized to enrich our students.

To facilitate home-school cooperation, we have been using frequently various channels to enhance home-school communication, especially through the monthly meetings with the Principal, as we believe that effective home-school cooperation is essential for the betterment of our students. With the help from the PTA Chairman, the school has succeeded in re-establishing our close link with the Kadoorie Family and the school is going to celebrate our Founder's day – for sustaining Kadoorie families' philanthropic tradition in the minds of our students.

Lastly, I would like to express my heartfelt thanks to the Chairman, Mr. Nachiappan Thirupathi and all the executive members of PTA under whose leadership our Parent-Teacher Association has been very supportive and enthusiastic about various aspects of the school.
