To organize a Learning Skills Workshop for S.4 students with the focus on effective learning and study skills	1st term	S.4 elite students for the workshop, other S.4 students for the lecture	\$8,000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 50 elite students participated in the learning skills workshop in Apr 2024 ● 20 students participated in the learning skills lecture in Apr 2024. ● Student survey showed that the majority of participants (over 90%) agreed that the workshop is useful for their learning in senior form. ● Students' feedback showed that the workshop and talk can equip them with techniques to enhance their study.
To organize a Revision Skills Workshop for S.5 elite students with the focus on revision techniques and tools	1st term	S.5 elite students	\$4,800	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 42 elite students have participated in a one hour workshops on revision and time management skills in Apr 2024 ● Various revision skills and time managements skills were illustrated and practiced in the workshop. ● Student survey showed that the majority of participants (over 90%) agreed that the workshop is useful for their learning in senior form.
To organize a speaking / debate training for talented students	1 st term	Outstanding student debaters in the debating team	\$18,000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 12 students have participated in a series of 9 hours debating training from Nov to Dec 2023. ● All of them agreed that the workshops were very inspiring and enriched their debating and presentation skills. ● 3 students were further selected to practice the skills in open debate competition and managed to win 2 rounds.

To arrange workshop to stretch students' potential in logics and spatial intelligence	2 nd term	Talented students in spatial intelligence.	\$ 4,600 and \$ 7,200	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The workshop was not arranged since the number of students interested in this workshop is low. ● Creativity workshop was carried out in Mar 2024 instead. ● 15 selected S5 students were invited to participate. They have learnt some principle in design and have practiced the principles with small design and handcraft takes. ● More than 90% of students found it useful. ● STEAM in science workshop was also carried out instead in Apr 2024 ● 20 selected science students were involved. ● They have learnt the principles and application of DNA technology, magnetism, polymerization in food production. ● More than 90% of students enjoyed the workshop.
