Dear Parent/Guardian,

<u>PE Lesson Arrangement, Matters concerning School Uniforms, Half-day School, PTA</u> <u>AGM, P.6 Information Day, School Picnic, School Based Assessment and Speech Day</u>

Please be informed of the following matters:

1. <u>PE lesson arrangement (canoeing)</u>

In order to develop our students' multiple-intelligence on sports, our school is going to arrange canoeing activities in the campus during 4 - 8 November in PE lessons. Four temporary small-size swimming pools will be set up in our playground. Please be informed that all those facilities can only be used under teacher's **DIRECT** supervision. Otherwise, students should stay away from the facilities at all times. Should you have any questions, please feel free to contact Mr. LIN at 2576 1871.

2. <u>Matters concerning School Uniforms</u>

A. <u>Winter School Uniform</u>

With effect from Monday, <u>11 November 2019</u>, students may opt to wear winter uniform. From Monday, <u>25 November 2019</u>, it will be compulsory for all students to wear winter uniform.

Please note that sweaters should be navy blue V-neck with the school logo and jackets should be navy blue fleece jackets with the school badge. Boys must wear plain black belts with simple buckles. For girls admitted in or after 2016/17 academic year, the new pale blue, cotton blend pin striped blouse should be worn.

B. Arrangement of non-uniform jackets and scarf during winter

When the *Cold Weather Warning* is issued or temperature falls to 15 °C, plain navy blue, dark blue or black jackets or scarf may be worn on top of the school sweater or school jacket if necessary. Please be reminded that denim jackets, leather jackets and pullover sweaters are not permitted. If students fail to follow the guidelines mentioned above, the school will take away and keep these non-uniform items.

For details of the uniform regulations, please refer to the school uniform regulations on pages 3 - 5 of the student's handbook.

3. <u>Half-day School</u>

As indicated in the school calendar 2019/2020, **12 November 2019**, and **23 April 2020** are stipulated for "*Collaborative Lesson Preparation and Teachers' Sharing on Teaching Strategies*". Students should leave school at 12:25 pm on these two days.

4. <u>28th PTA AGM and Parents' Night</u>

To foster closer home-school co-operation and to offer better guidance to individual students, the Annual PTA AGM and Parents' Night is scheduled to be held on Friday, <u>15 November</u> <u>2019</u>, from 6:00 pm to 8:45 pm. Parents/Guardians are cordially invited to come and discuss with the Class Teacher the academic progress and conduct of your child/ward at school, and to <u>collect his/her First Term Test Report Sheet</u>. Students are strongly advised to come with parents/guardians on Parents' Night and **all students should be in proper school uniform**. 5. <u>P.6 Information Day</u>

The "P6 Information Day" is scheduled on 22 November 2019 (Friday) which will be a normal school day for our students.

Since more than 250 P6 students, teachers and parents will visit our school in the morning on that day, around 70 students from S.2 to S.6 will serve as student helpers. Parents of those student helpers will be informed about the details via the student handbook in due course.

They should prepare their own lunch.

Please be informed that the School Picnic is an important school function in which all students must take part. All students must arrive at school on that day before 8:15 am. Coaches will depart at 8:30 am. Students who do not participate in this activity for health reasons must stay at school under normal school hours. Some assignments will be arranged for them to work on under the supervision of teachers.

7. <u>SBA Notice Regarding S5 and S6 Students</u>

In order to enhance the validity of the public assessment, SBA (School Based Assessment) will be included in some subjects in the HKDSE examination. SBA refers to assessments administered in school and marked by the students' own teachers. SBA marks awarded will count towards students' public assessment results.

SBA marks, students' work samples and related assessment documents of S6 will be submitted by school between late 2019 and early 2020 whereas SBA marks of S5 will be kept in school pending submission in the next academic year. The following subjects are involved in SBA:

1. 體育課堂安排(獨木舟)

甲、 更換冬季校服
