### **EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE PARENT-MEMBERS ELECTION**

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, our school will comply with the Centre for Health Protection guidelines on preventive measures. In this regard, the 29<sup>th</sup> PTA AGM and Parents' Night scheduled on 20 November 2020 will not be held at school. However, it was unanimously agreed that the PTA Executive Committee members will be elected by casting of vote by the parent and teacher members in secret ballot according to the PTA constitution. SMC Parent representative will be elected in the same way but by parent members only. Ballot papers and candidates' election statements are issued to parents via their children along with this letter.

Regarding the **First Term Test Report**, class teachers will telephone you to discuss the academic progress and conduct of your child/ward at school. Students will bring home the photocopy of the First Term Test Report. The photocopy should be signed and returned to the class teacher. Afterwards, the First Term Test Report proper will be issued for your retention. Details for this arrangement will be provided to all parents in Parents' Letter No. 10.

<u>As per Article 5(d) of the PTA Constitution</u>: The Annual General Meeting shall be held during the month of November or December each year. Please find enclosed the Principal's Address (2020-2021), PTA annual report (PTA Chairperson) and Financial Report for the year 2019-2020.

Along with this letter is a ballot paper including <u>One resolution</u> to be proposed in the 29th AGM of PTA for an amendment in item 4 clause (d) of the PTA Constitution:

- Ordinary members should pay an annual membership fee of <u>HK\$100</u> per family
- If approved, it will be effective from 2021-2022 school year

Please indicate whether or not to pass the resolution on the ballot paper. Please read carefully the "Voting Guidelines" on the ballot paper before casting your vote.

### **Voting method:**

Drop the ticked ballot paper in person or through your child/ward in the ballot box at the school foyer on 17<sup>th</sup> or 18<sup>th</sup>November by 4:00pm or latest by 19<sup>th</sup> November by 12:30 pm.

Another <u>four</u> parents will be elected to sit on the 29<sup>th</sup> Executive Committee and <u>one</u> SMC Parent Representative to sit on the School Management Committee. The candidate lists and election information are provided overleaf.

### **CANDIDATE LISTS & ELECTION INFORMATION**

According to the PTA Constitution, a new Executive Committee will be formed by election. The Executive Committee comprises eight elected parent-members and seven teacher-members (appointed by school). Among the eight parent-members, four will serve another year of office (2020-2021). They are Mrs. Marian Bautista Leung, Mr. Mohammad Nadim, Mr. DulalIshwor Prasad and Mrs. Chan Violeta Domondon.

The four outgoing members Ms. Stefania Gabriel, Mr. Eduardo Z. Talledo, Mr. Subodh Kumar Ojha and Mrs. Rachel C. Galang have completed their term of office (2018-2020).
 By voting, another four parents will be elected to sit on the 29<sup>th</sup> Executive Committee. There are <u>six</u> candidates contesting the election for 29<sup>th</sup> PTA Executive Committee. Details of the candidates can be found in the attached candidate lists.

For School Management Committee (SMC), only one parent will be elected to sit on the SMC board. Out of two parent representatives **Mr. Eduardo Z. Talledo** will continue to serve one more year (**2020-2021**), and the outgoing member is **Mrs. Rachel C. Galang (2018-2020)** as she has completed her two-year term of office. There are <u>three</u> candidates contesting for SMC Parent Representative. Details of the candidates can be found in the attached candidate lists.

### **Eligibility to vote**

PTA membership is mandatory for all parents and guardians. Each membership is entitled to <u>one</u> vote.

### **Counting of ballots**

The ballots for the PTA Executive Committee Parent-members Election will be counted under the supervision of the Principal, the PTA chairperson and in the presence of two PTA teacher members.

### **Declaration of results**

The results of the election and proposed resolution will be declared once all the ballots have been counted and all the parents will be informed by parents' letter.
