

Message from the Principal



With the dedicated support from our parents throughout the year, Sir EK has been growing stronger as the positive school culture is reinforced through a series of specially designed school improvement plans. The past year has been a fruitful one – not only did our students receive various prizes and awards during the year, what is more encouraging is that seven of our students were admitted to degree courses in the University of Hong Kong.

A number of renovation and improvement work have been taken place during summer holiday such as replacement of switches, set up WiFi network in the whole school, purchase of ipads and installation of computers in classrooms. All the improvement work aims at providing our school with a better network system for promoting e-learning such as web-based learning and online learning which are more interactive and can arouse students' interest in learning.

Based on the well-established multicultural learning environment, various new programmes will be arranged for our students this year.

- (a) For S1, ECA & Chinese Culture Appreciation and Sports Training are arranged for S1 students after school on Monday and Wednesday respectively. Through the programmes, the new comers are able to enjoy school life and their sense of belonging can definitely be enhanced. Mathematics tutorial class will be arranged on small group for them during lunch time on every Friday to consolidate their understandings in Mathematics.
- (b) STEM lessons (STEM is the combination of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics Education) are incorporated in S2 curriculum. In the STEM lessons, students

will have project work in which their creativity and problem-solving skills can be enriched.

- (c) We have joined the EDB Sister School Program. Our sister school is a foreign language school in Shenzhen (Shenzhen Pingshan New Area Tongxin Foreign Language School). We are planning to arrange all the S3 students to visit the school in April 2018.
- (d) Career and multiple pathways are always our main focus for senior form students. The school keeps on exposing students to various career opportunities and providing students with work experiences via immersion programmes with non-government organizations and corporations.

With the joint effort of teachers and parents, I am confident that we can create the best learning environment for our students.

Once again, I would like to emphasize the efforts paid by the PTA in making our school a better place. I would like to take this opportunity to express my heartfelt thanks to the Chairperson, Mrs. Asha Rai, as well as all the executive members of PTA who have offered their unfailing support to our school.
